ICCG's role and responsibilities – ICCG standard ToR:

- Supporting service delivery across clusters
- Supporting analysis, planning and monitoring
- Integrating cross-sectoral issues into response
- Identifying advocacy concerns and requesting HCT to advocate or provide direction

ICCG Performance Monitoring

- Based on the ICCG ToR
- At the request of OCHA COs
- Developed by OCHA and the GCCG to help ICCGs assess their performance, identify gaps and required actions

ICCG Performance Monitoring Tool

ICCG performance monitoring should be undertaken at least once a year in protracted crises and within three to six months after the group set up

Step 1: The Survey

It allows for collection of members' perception and reflection on the general performance of the ICCG based on the approved ToR.

Step 2: Analysis of the Results and Report

Results from the survey gathered and analyzed, using the report template

Step 3: Organize a meeting/workshop

ICCG will hold a dedicated meeting/retreat to review and discuss the findings of the survey to be able to define an Action Plan, with follow up actions, timeframe and responsible focal points







Roll out

- Field test: Ethiopia, Chad, DRC, Burundi
 - Positive feedback
 - Easy to use and flexible tool
 - Used for ICCG retreats to assess ICCG's performance, to identify areas to improve and to develop Action plans, with clear deliverables, timelines and responsibilities
- Ready for roll-out: sharing with OCHA field offices; webinars to present the tool.
