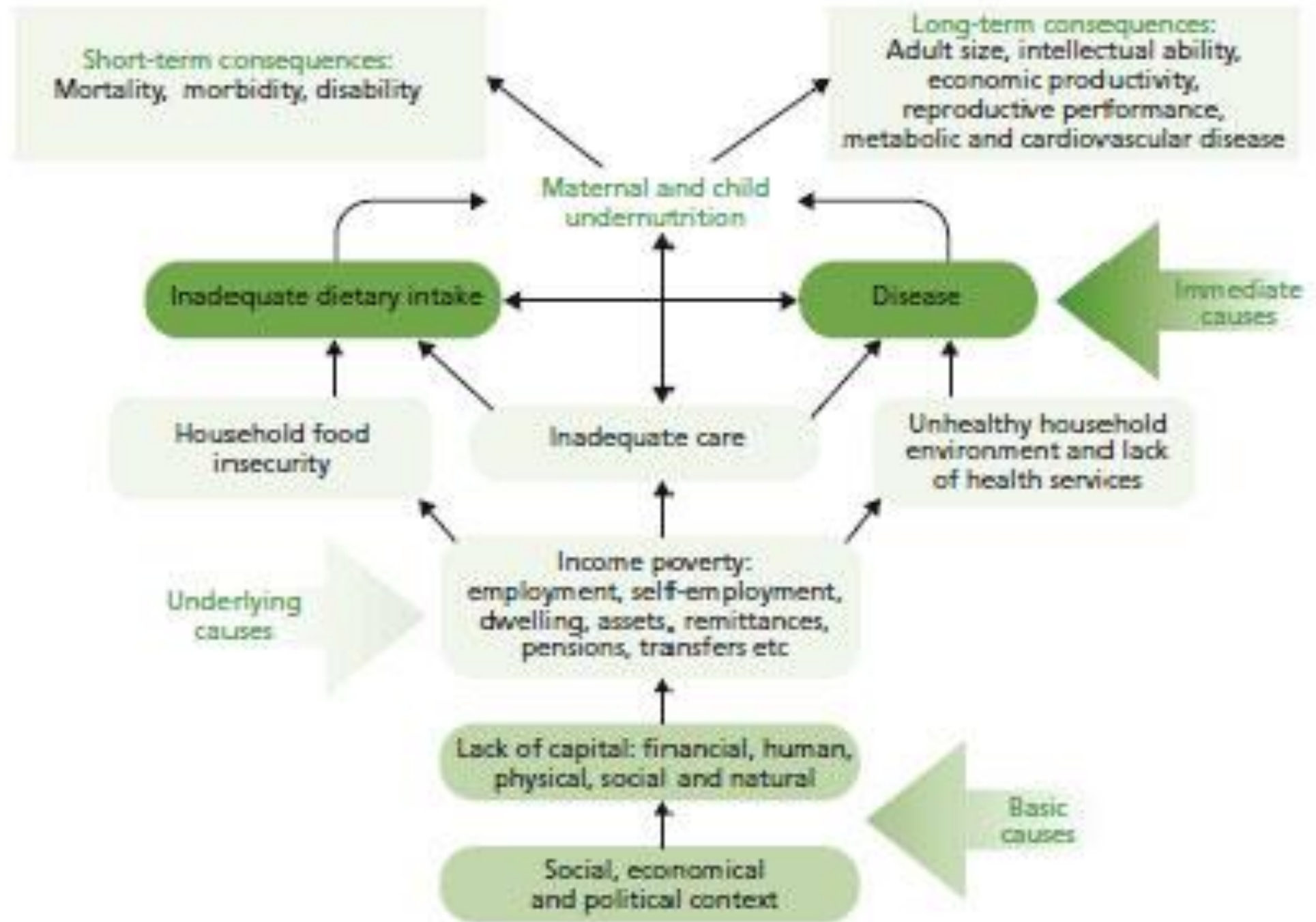


Executive summary

A structure to support integration is in place...

- Intercluster nutrition working group (GNC and gFSC partners) formed in 2012
- Engagement with GHC and GWC strengthened since 2018
- An Integration Helpdesk established to support country integration
- Consultants with experience in integration are being selected

...and tools are developed to kick start integration...

- Training/workshop package – 3 days – EN and FR
 - Day 1 – why important to work together
 - Day 2 – how to work together
 - Day 3 – development of an action plan to work together
- Collection of the best tools and practices
 - As part of the workshop package
- Working on the case studies on challenges

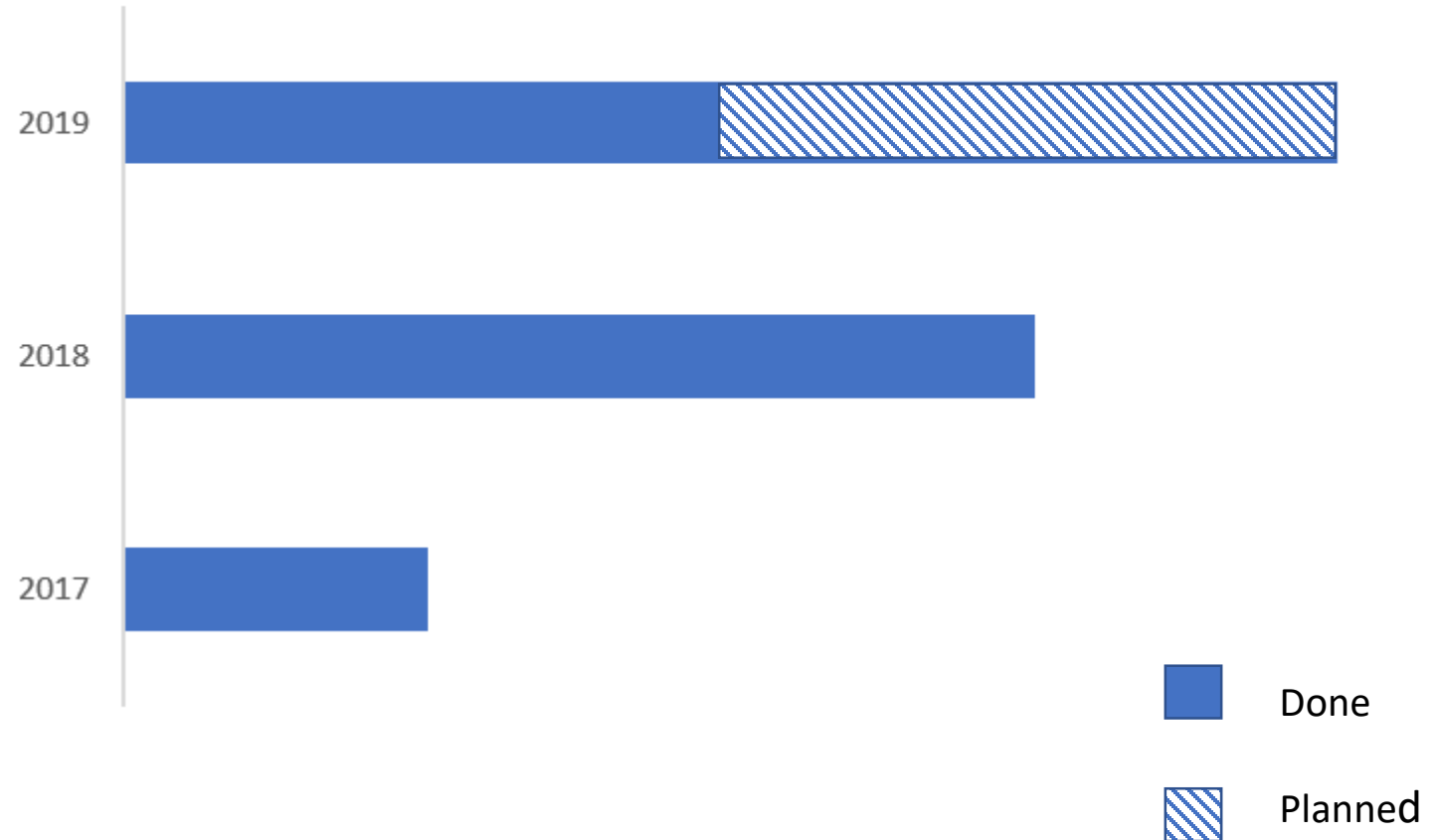
