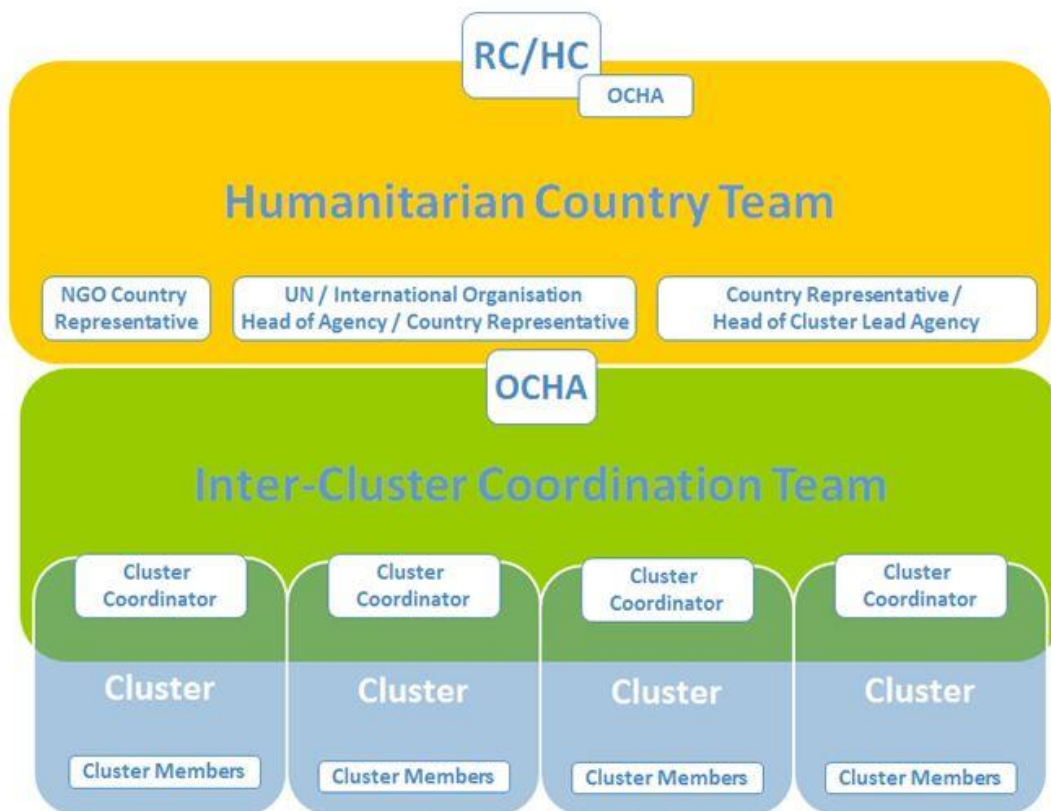

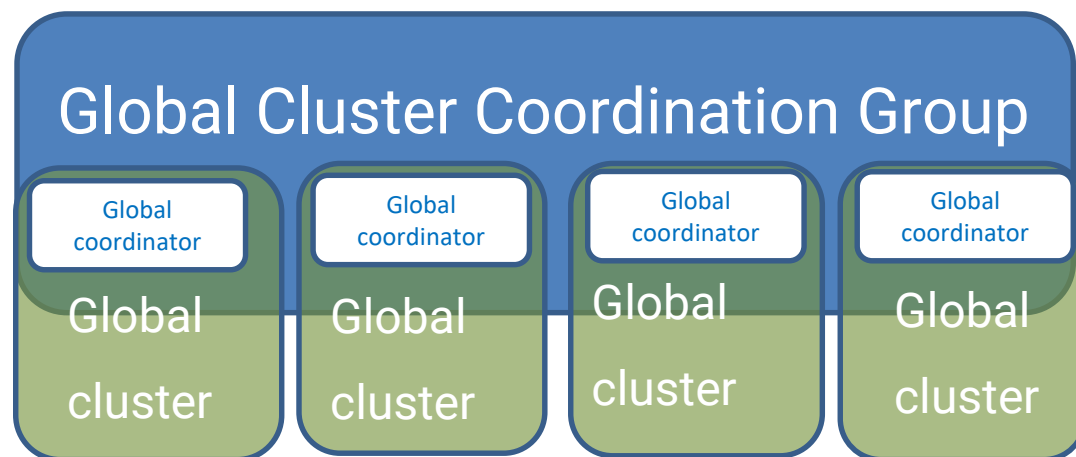

GCCG main achievements in 2018

Collective action and standardization:

- Revised CCPM guidance
- Development of an ICCG performance monitoring tool – field testing and roll-out
- Joint workstreams GCCG-IMWG
- Contribution to HPC strengthening
- Data collection and analysis on coordination structures in-country

Way forward – GCCG 2019 workplan

- More focus on field support: where challenges and gaps in ICC and coordination structures; but also countries focusing on HDN, or where P2P and EDG attention / missions
- Collection and analysis of data on humanitarian coordination architecture – for the EDG ARO and for constant updates on the Coordination architecture
- GCCG engagement with new workstreams and partners (CE/AAP, localization, private sector – how to engage with, donors - advocacy)
- And more, depending on IASC priorities
